Lux Centre Revenue 2000/2001

First of all I am pleased to inform you that both the BFI and the Film Council have now confirmed LFVDA's funding for 2000/2001 and this year there are no unpleasant surprises.

Secondly, the Lux application has been circulated to the LFVDA Board and discussed at the meeting held on the 14 March. The board were impressed by the quality of the revenue application and have instructed me to pass on the following decisions:

The Lux Centre should plan on the basis of a standstill grant for 2000/2001

LFVDA is re-evaluating the areas to which its resources are directed and intends to re-formulate policy during April and May 2000

In the meantime, LFVDA will issue all revenue clients with an interim offer letter confirming six months funding at 1999/2000 levels

The financial package for the final six months of the year will be agreed as soon as possible, subject to the policy review, and guidelines will be attached indicating targets and outcomes which will be agreed with you in advance.

This is an important step towards adopting policy and procedures that apply across all our clients and funding applications. If you want to discuss this with me then please don't hesitate to phone. The offer letter will be sent to you during the week beginning 21 March. Subject to the LFVDA receiving its quarterly funding from the BFI, your first quarter's payment of £30,704 will be paid at the beginning of April.

With regard to the letter received from Geoffrey Horley concerning Lux capital, and copied to you and Mik, the LFVDA board are currently looking further into the matter.
