Relocation of LEA/LFMC

Following our meeting with officers from the Government Office for London, I am pleased to be able to confirm the level of funding which the Institute will be putting into the project to relocate LEA/LFMC to Hoxton Square. As indicated in the submission to the European Regional Development Fund we have made a commitment to provide £166,668 (one hundred and sixty six thousand six hundred and sixty eight pounds) to the project during the eligible period.

As you are aware, the Institute has already made a substantial financial contribution to the project before the identification of Hoxton Square as the best location which is not included in the total above. Please note that the above total does not include an allocation for continuing help in kind, consultancy services by Institute officers or any other non-cash contribution to the project. It also does not include any assessment of continuing financial support to the project after the end of the current business planning period.
