Thank you for your email of today. The Board has met this evening and we are willing to accept your proposal.

Here are our answers to your points:

- Emma has kindly agreed to meet with Ben Cook on our behalf to discuss the sub-distribution deal.
- We will be working out a figure for the current royalties and will forward it to you by the end of next week.
- We will set up a meeting with Monomyth to discuss the website. In the meantime we enclose the contractual agreement between Cinenova and Monomyth as well as the text of an email from Monomyth outlining their position with regard to collaboration with another organisation.
- We will be circulating the filmmakers to inform them of the situation before we can move materials to the Lux. Some of them may not want their material to be transferred. We will talk about transferring equipment with Ben and Four Corners.
- We are discussing the makeup and activities of a "shadow Board".
- As mentioned above, we will be contacting filmmakers shortly.

Regarding NOF, we are still concerned about the situation and we feel that this needs further discussion. As you suggest that "we could pull together projects which could be individually funded"; this is surely such a project.
