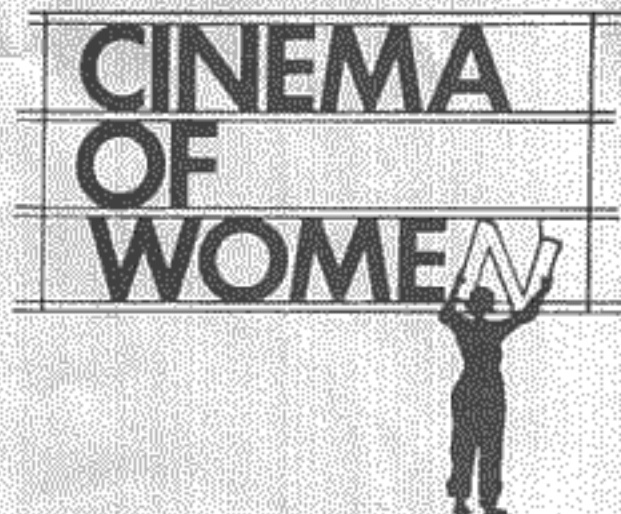

Dear Circles Management Committee

We are now in receipt of Gill Henderson's letter on behalf of the Circles Management Committee in response to our letter of 23 April. Though your response does go a little way in shedding some light on the events of the past few weeks, there still remain for us many areas of grave concern vis a vis Circles' handling of the whole affair. In particular, it seems at best unfortunate that you chose not to put any trust in Cinema of Women, whom you had been working alongside for well over a year in the face of considerable opposition from the BFI.

However, the purpose of this letter is to request, once again, a copy of the budget for the new company, as well as a planned programme of activities. We understand that you do not now plan to call the new company "Take Two". Perhaps you could let us know what it will be called so that we may inform our filmmakers of the relevant particulars. We are holding our AGM on Thursday 9 May and it is imperative that we have this information to present to our Board of Directors, as well as to our filmmakers.

We trust you will deal with this matter with the utmost urgency.
