Dear Chris,

Please find enclosed comments from our solicitors on the head lease as it stands at present. They seem to be fairly happy, but obviously want the details to be filled in. I have to say, though, that I would want the sort of things the landlord could object to on the grounds of "nuisance to other tenants" to be laid down very clearly, as we don't want to be prevented from operating as normal because of people complaining about noise, nor do we want the landlord or other tenants to have the tiniest amount of control over our programme if it should become controversial. Also, with reference to needing the landlord's consent to window displays we would need written guarantees that they will allow projections onto the front window, and not attempt to censor us, at least if the local authority is happy with what we are doing. I will be asking our solicitors about this, but would appreciate your comments.

Has any more progress been made ? Things seem to be dragging a little.
