ARTS COUNCIL INCENTIVE FUND

At the last Regional Consultative Committee, I was asked to ascertain the position of film, video and broadcasting organisations' applications to the Arts Council of Great Britain Incentive Fund 89/90.

The following statement will be included in the information sent out to prospective applicants to the Fund by ACGB:

"Ineligible Organisations

Organisations whose ONLY arts funding is received from the BFI or the Crafts Council, either directly or channelled via a Regional Arts Association are NOT eligible to apply for Arts Council Incentive funding. An organisation with mixed funding is eligible to apply but is restricted to activities within the Arts Council's remit. Projects or plans that fall within the BFI's or Crafts Council's remits are not eligible for consideration under ACGB incentive funding.

The BFI and the CC both operate their own incentive schemes. If you are unsure which scheme your project is most appropriate to, please confirm with the BFI, Crafts Council or the relevant departments of the ACGB. "
